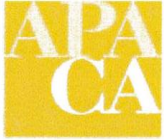
This year there will be up to four \$500 scholarships awarded to student members of APA. Student currently attending San Diego State University or University of California San Diego and Members of APA are eligible to apply. The scholarship winners will receive free admission to all San Diego Section APA educational functions for the remainder of the year.

The attached application should be filled out and submitted to: Sara Osborn by **April 15th, 2014**. A committee of San Diego APA Section board members, in consultation with faculty at each university, will select the award winner from each school. The awards will be presented at the 2014 APA San Diego Annual Awards Event at the New Central Library on Wednesday, May 14th.

Basic criteria are:

- You are a full-time student at San Diego State University or University of California San Diego working towards a planning related degree;
- You are a student member of APA [Note: if you are not currently a student member, you may join APA by going to <http://www.planning.org/join>. Student membership is \$60 per year.];
- You are not a previous CPF scholarship winner.
